## Co-Curricular Drama program - St Peter's Players 2020

Dear Parents, Carers and Students,

W elcome to the St Peter's Players Program for semester one 2020! You will need to complete an enrolment form for the terms 1 and 2 classes. Another enrolment form detailing second semester classes will be issued towards the end of term 2.

St Peter's Players is an opportunity for you to pursue or extend your Drama experience through a selection of classes that cater for your specific interest. The classes are taught by professional theatre practitioners.

Classes are assembled across year groups to develop ensemble and foster collaboration. Classes require a minimum of eight participants, or they will not proceed. Classes are capped at 15.

The classes require your commitment for the semester. Classes do not run in every week and you should refer to the term calendars below. You should also consider your established commitments with other co-curricular activities and remain supportive to them. The St Peter's Players program will offer a different focus each semester.

The development of your drama skills requires ready and regular application; work is dependent on the contribution of the ensemble and a continuity of learning. Please note your prompt attention to enrolment is advised.

Rehearsals for our June production of Ladies in Black will take place on W ednesday and Friday afternoons and Sundays. Ladies in Black auditions are open to all girls in Years 7 to 11.
