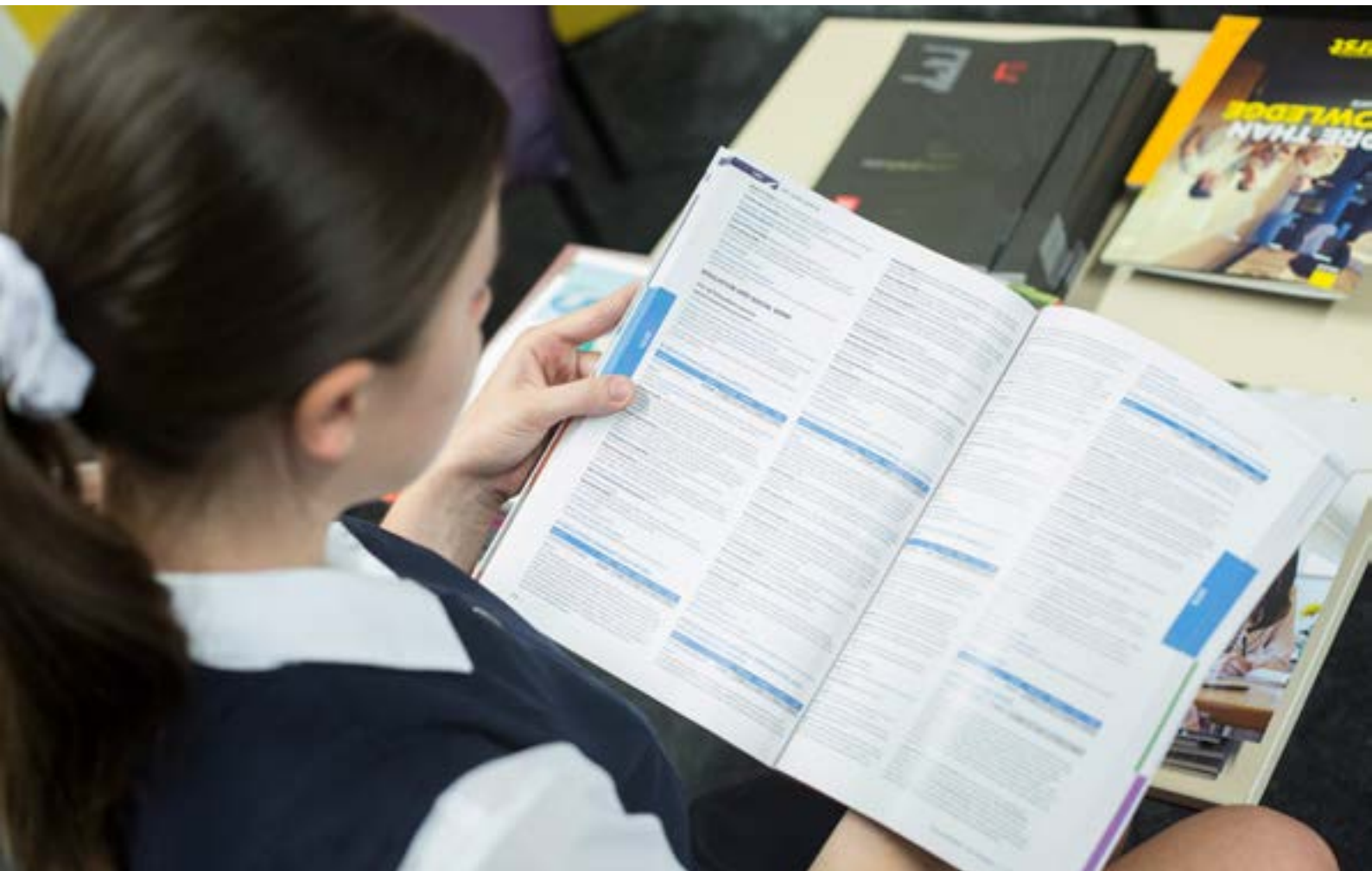

The University Clinical Aptitude Test - Book by Monday 11 May

Are you thinking of studying medicine in 2021?

You may be wondering if your ability to sit the UCAT test may be affected. UCAT has released some information about the impact the coronavirus may have on testing.

Announcement from Vice Chancellor, [Macquarie University](#)

Macquarie University has announced that any applicant who meets the criteria for their Early Entry Schemes, which offer students a place at Macquarie based on their Year 11 results, will be made an offer to study at Macquarie in 2021. There will be no cap on the number of students at the University level who will be admitted through these schemes to support students concerned about impacts to their study and ATAR results from the COVID-19 Pandemic. Caps will only exist at course level when there are government, legal, or other logistical restraints (clinical placements etc). For the first time Macquarie University is also announcing the removal of exemptions to courses available through their two early entry schemes - the Schools Recommendation Scheme (open now) and Leaders and Achievers Early Entry Scheme.

- Involvement and achievement in a range of activities and interests
- Demonstrated leadership qualities or potential
- Academic ability (desirable ATAR: 95)

You can also view admission requirements including minimum selection rank, prerequisites, study options, and any additional entry requirements that are required as part of your application.

Check that you meet the co-curricular or service requirement. The co-curricular or service requirement considers the knowledge you have developed outside of the classroom and recognises this in your ANU application. You'll need to provide documentation to support your activities over the last two years, such as school reports or certificates for community activities.
