At the audition you should bring the item that you would like to be considered for inclusion in THAT COVID SHOW. Remember ... the only stipulation is that it should be a response to the range of events that have impacted 2020. We encourage work that you construct but understandably there are going to be songs, monologues etc that you find which will be very appropriate to our creative vision.

We encourage you to also remember the filmed medium in which this entertainment will reach its audience.

You should attend the audition with a 'pitch' of what your item could be. You should attempt to prepare some of it for display but be mindful that if you are not successful you haven't invested too much time. Eg. If you would like to offer a dance item, you should attend audition with your dancers and tell us what your dance will communicate. You should also demonstrate your dance skills.

**As a performer, you could contribute as:**

- **An actor**
- **A dancer**
- **A singer**
- **An instrumentalist**
- **A speaker of poetry**

**As a creative you could contribute:**

- **A poem**
- **A song**
- **A composition**
- **A monologue**
- **A scene**
- **Choreography**

Rehearsals will take place every Monday and Wednesday after school through term 3. You will be given call times to rehearse and will not necessarily be required every week. The rehearsal period is shorter than previous SCEGGS productions. Your total commitment is required so that we may construct the show as efficiently as possible.
