# University of Tasmania Schools Recommendation Program Now Open

Year 12 students can submit their free application to the 2022 Schools Recommendation Program at the University of Tasmania. Rather than an ATAR, students are assessed based on their school's recommendation and their Year 11 results. The program is open for most of the University's undergraduate degrees, and early offers will be issued from July. Get your application in by 18 June to be eligible for a first-round offer!

## University of Newcastle - Joint Medical Program - How to Apply – 3 Steps

If you have already registered for UCAT and want to apply for the University of Newcastle Joint Medical Program in 2022, you must complete the following three steps.

- 1. Complete the UCAT and HSC
- 2. Receive an ATAR of at least 94.30
- 3. Attend a multi-station interview panel

Remember, the University of Newcastle Joint Medical Program is world-class and entry is competitive. Each year, 170 places are available in the program across both the University of Newcastle and the University of New England; more than 3,500 people apply for those spaces. Your application will go through a <u>rigorous selection process</u>. If your application isn't successful, you are encouraged to apply again the following year or to consider one of the many alternative degrees offered by the <u>University of Newcastle</u> or the <u>University of New England</u>.
