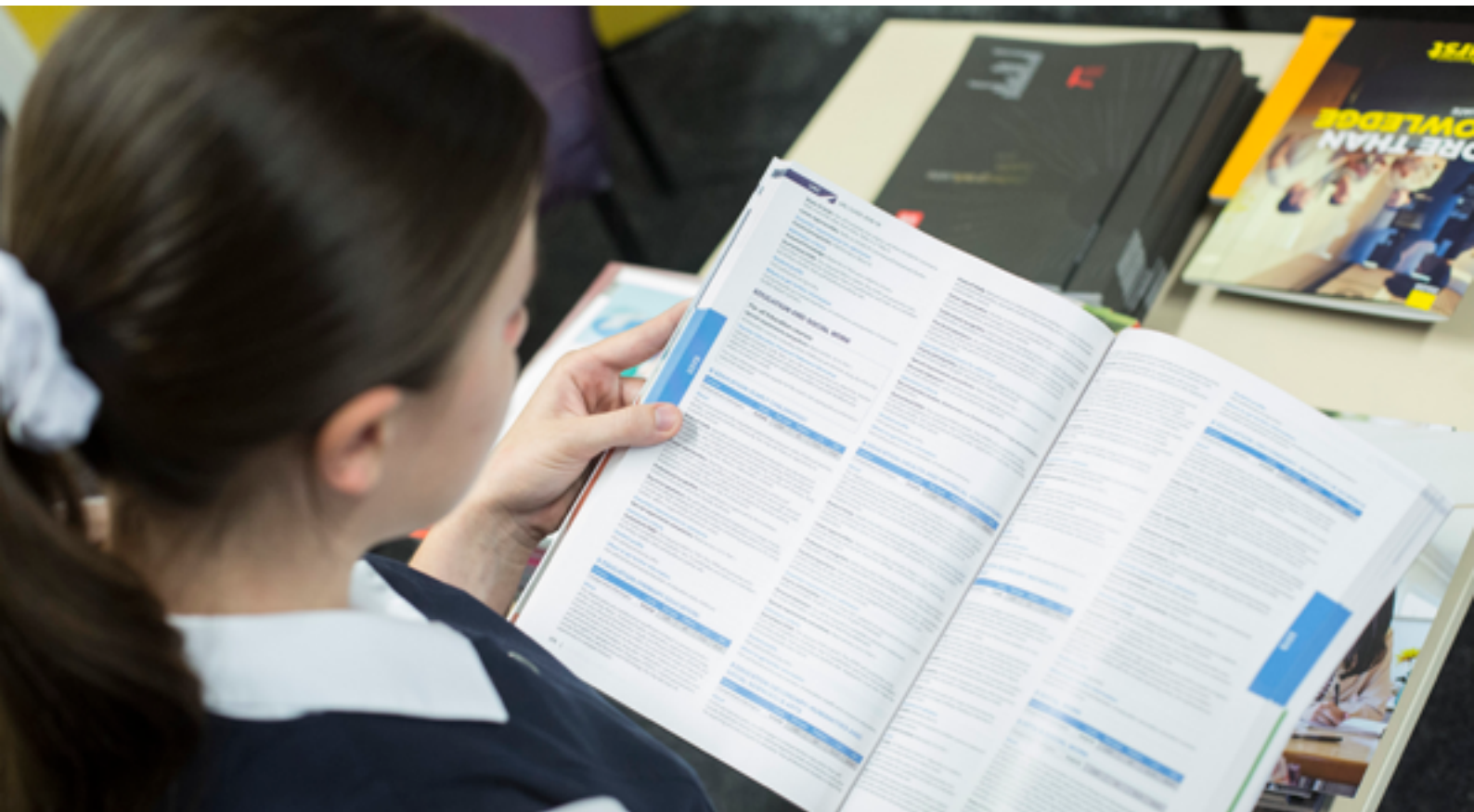

Any student applying to a U.S. university should join this webinar to learn how to use Common App. Common App is an undergraduate college admission application that students must use to apply to attend a university or College in the USA.

Students who are interested in applying to study in the USA should contact Mr Gallagher as soon as possible. Every college has slightly nuanced requirements, so please talk to Mr Gallagher sooner rather than later so that he is aware of the different documentation you may need, eg Yr 9-12 educational transcripts or multiple academic references, and the timeframes for all of your applications.
